REMOTE MONITORING STATION LAND USE PERMIT HAINES, ALASKA

The University of Alaska ("University") intends to issue a land use permit authorizing the installation and operation of a remote weather and monitoring station near 19-mile Haines Highway northwest of Haines, Alaska. The permit term is through December 31, 2030.

This disposal plan is effective as long as the University owns the parcel.

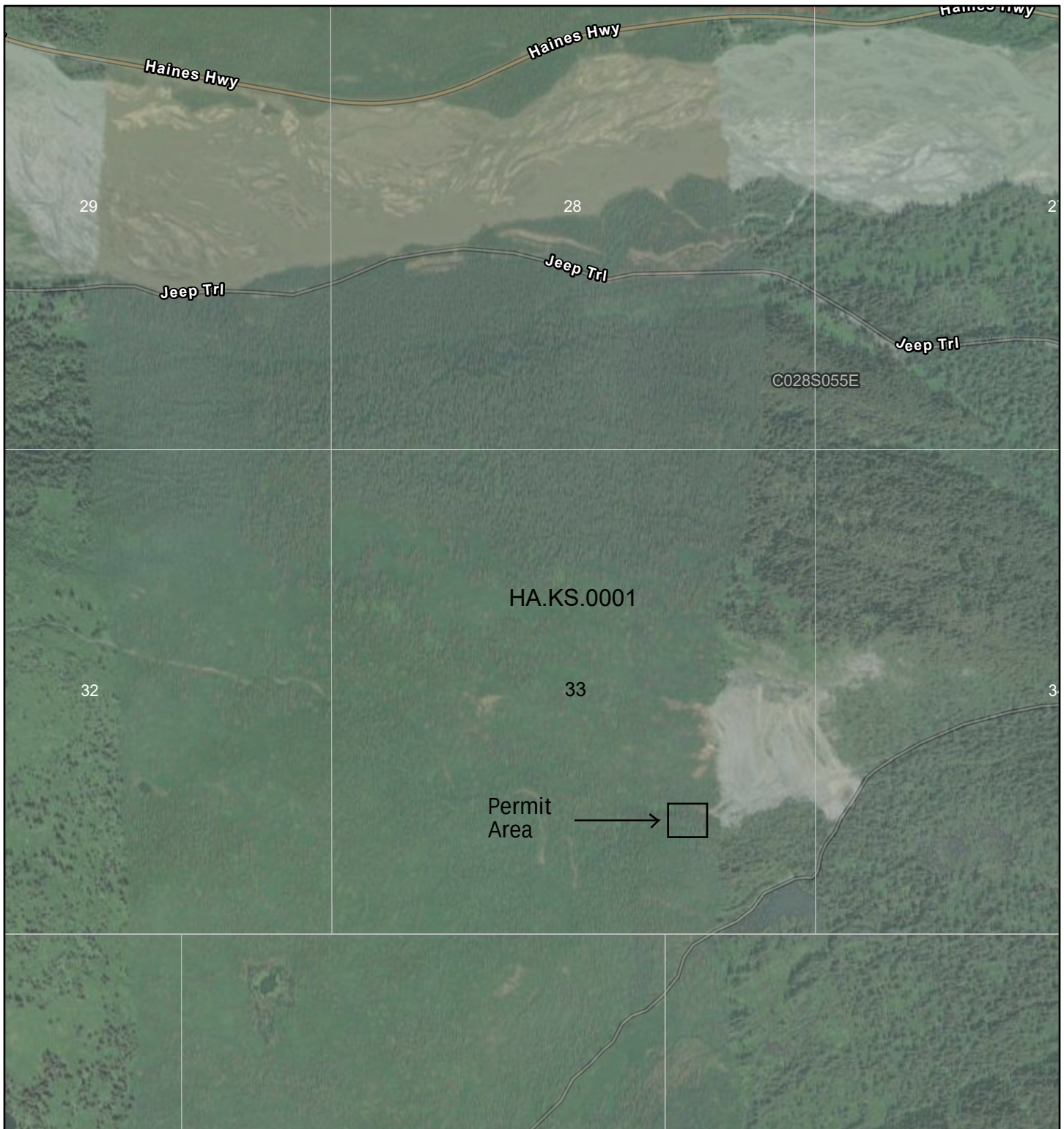

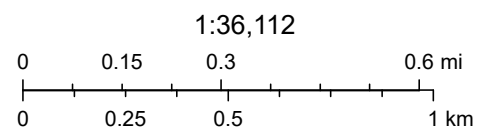
